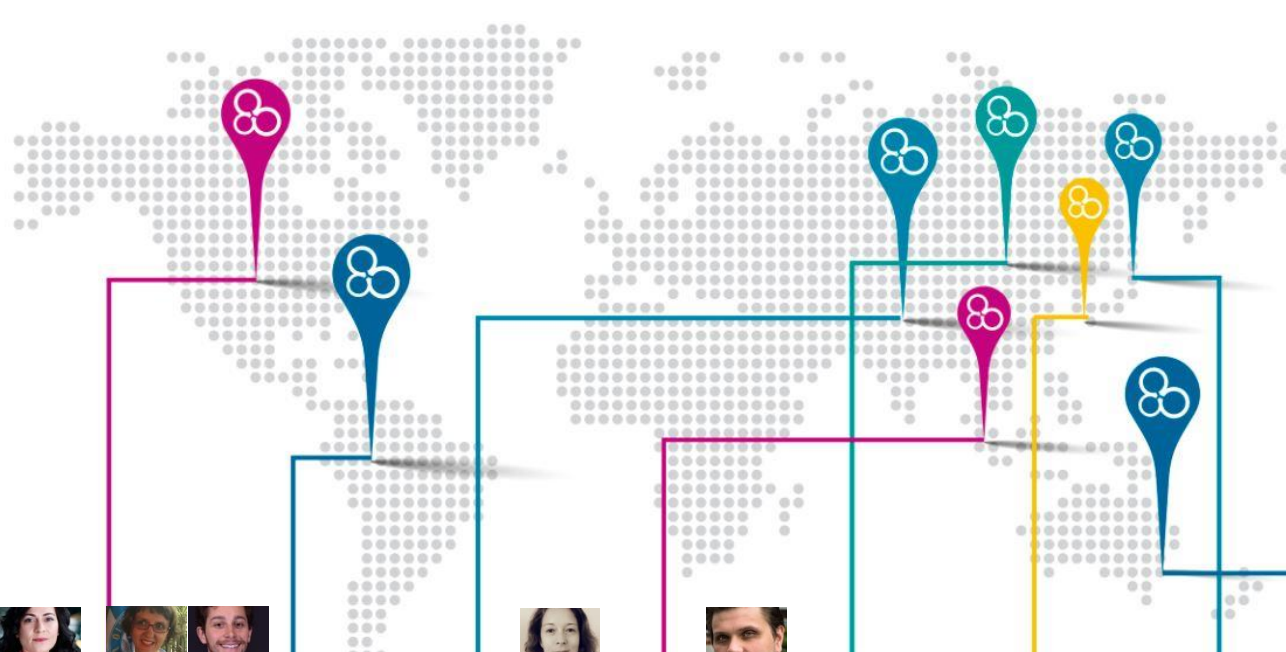

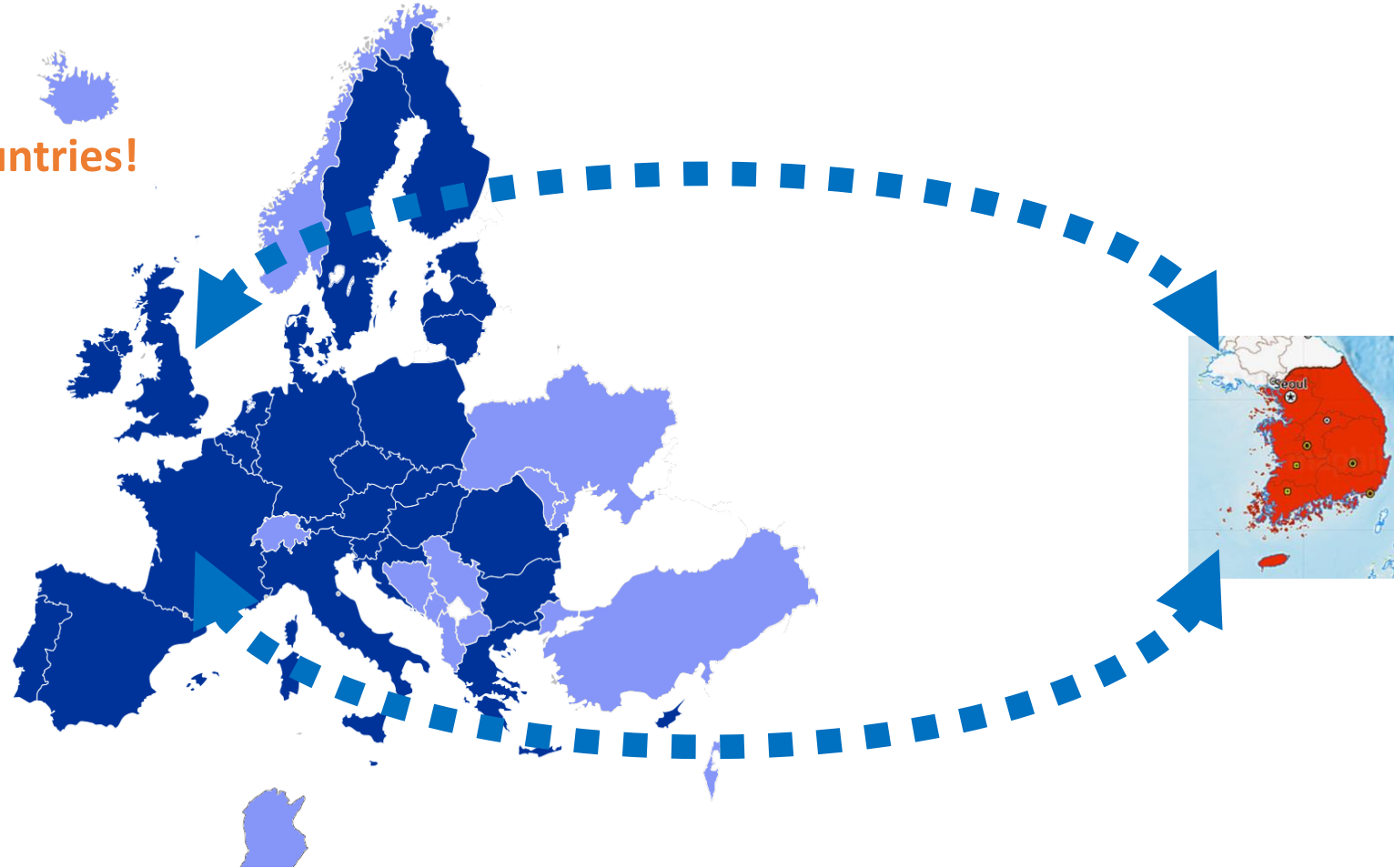

Toward Horizon Europe

- Since 1984, European Community research and technological development activities have been defined and implemented by a series of **Framework Programmes** for Research and Technological Development (Framework Programmes, FP, or FP1-FP9).
- The FPs have been the main financial tools through which the EU supports research and development activities covering almost all scientific disciplines. FPs are proposed by the European Commission and adopted by Council and the European Parliament following a co-decision procedure. The budget for FPs started with 3.8 billion Euro for FP1 and has increased ever since to **95.5 billion Euro for Horizon Europe (FP9)**
- FP8, **Horizon 2020**, ran from 2014–2020 and provided an estimated 80 billion Euro of funding for research and innovation projects through open and competitive calls for proposals
- The current FP, Horizon Europe or FP9, focuses on **improving the objectives** in the previous framework, H2020, by supporting a broad range of member state science and research projects
- Horizon Europe was proposed by the European Commission on June 7, 2018.
- Further development of the program was constrained by the COVID-19 outbreak and budget reduction, but the agreement was finally reached at the end of 2020.

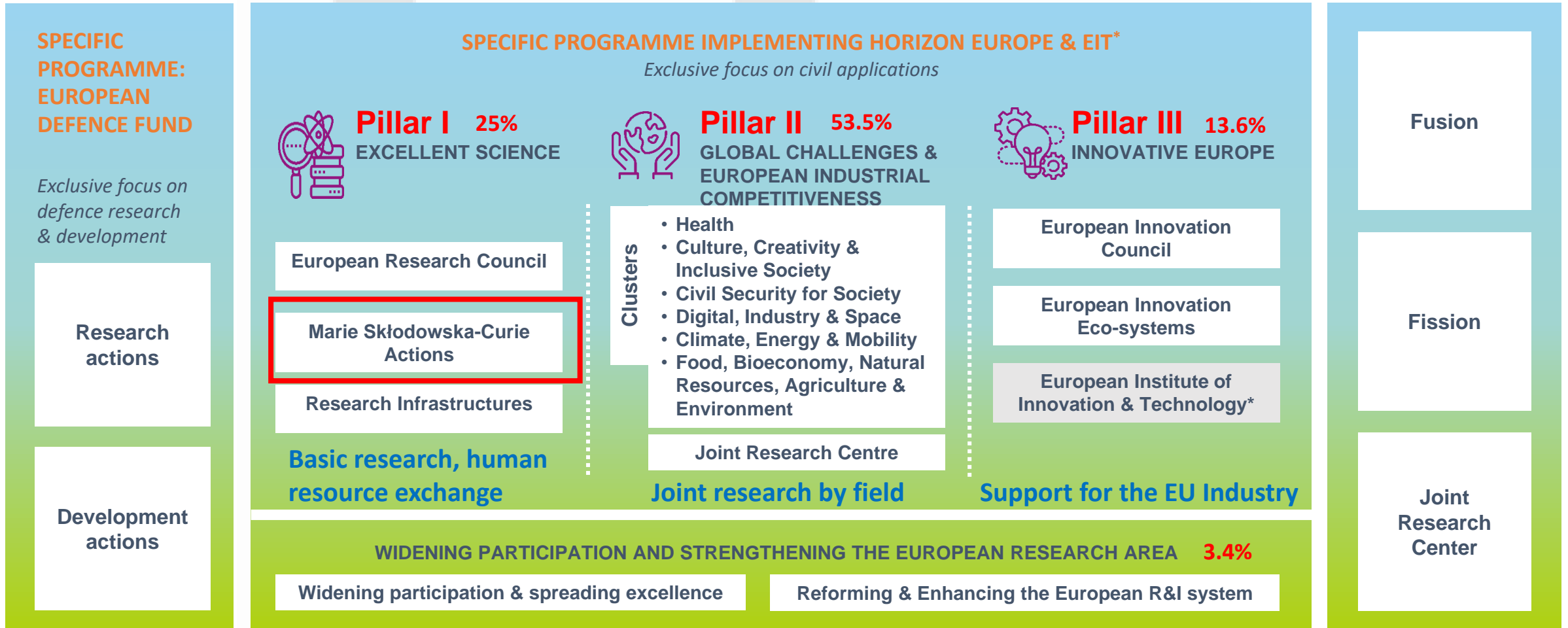
Horizon Europe

- Horizon Europe is the most ambitious program for research and innovation ever implemented
- In the years 2021-2027 Horizon Europe's beneficiaries will receive 95.5 billion Euro. The overall budget is 30% bigger compared to Horizon 2020
- The aim of this funding program is to address and solve the pending societal issues with a special focus on human resources, industrial modernization, infrastructure, and inter-regional collaboration
- The goal is also for Europe to transform science leadership into worldwide leadership in entrepreneurship and innovation by 2027
- Consortia formed of public-private partnerships are the main beneficiaries of this funding scheme (individuals can also apply for certain programs)
- The complex funding structure of Horizon Europe is organized similarly to the previous Framework Programmes and is composed of three pillars: Excellent Science; Global Challenges and European Industrial Competitiveness; and Innovative Europe.


Structure of Horizon Europe

Key tips for proposal template and layout

- **Acronym:** Use a self-explanatory title and a memorable acronym. Don't forget that you will not be able to change the acronym once you submit your proposal on the Funding and Tenders Portal.
- The acronym will be on your proposal and you will refer to it throughout your communication and dissemination activities. Ensure that the acronym is short, easy to pronounce, easy to remember by the evaluators, and that it cannot be construed as inappropriate or having a "double meaning" in English or in another language.
- Useful tool for creating an acronym: <http://acronymcreator.net/>
- The proposal acronym could be placed in a header on each page as an addition to already placed information: Call: [insert call identifier] — [insert call name] (e.g., Call: HORIZONMSCA-2023-PF-01: MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships 2023).
- Pay attention to the choice of keywords: they will be used to select the evaluators for your proposal.
- There is no cover page for the acronym & title

Proposal layout

- The page size is A4, and all margins (top, bottom, left, right) should be at least 15 mm (not including any footers or headers).
- The reference font for the body text of proposals is Times New Roman (Windows platforms), Times/Times New Roman (Apple platforms) or Nimbus Roman No. 9 L (Linux distributions).
- The use of a different font for the body text is not advised and is subject to the cumulative conditions that the font is legible and that its use does not significantly shorten the representation of the proposal in number of pages compared to using the reference font (for example with a view to bypassing the page limit).
- The minimum font size allowed is 11 points. Standard character spacing and a minimum of single line spacing is to be used.
