Our main aim...

To contribute to the strategic promotion of MSCA in 20 countries and 6 regions

- We will provide information ("intelligence") to the EC;
- We will organize promotion activities on an ad-hoc basis to fill observed gaps;
- We will produce recommendations for the strategic promotion of MSCA in the future



Our target countries and regions

At bilateral level the project will focus on key partner countries having concluded bilateral S&T Agreements with the EU: Algeria, Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Egypt, India, Japan, Jordan, Korea, Mexico, Morocco, New Zealand, South Africa, Switzerland, Tunisia, Ukraine and the United States.

At regional level the project will focus on bi-regional R&I policy dialogues, established notably with: African Union, ASEAN, LAC, Mediterranean partner countries, Eastern Partnership countries and Western Balkans.

- We will create synergies with MSCA-Net and EURAXESS WW.
- If and where needed, and in agreement with DG EAC we can step-in to fill a gap or to exploit an opportunity.



MSCAdvocacy for Korea: current objectives

- Envisaged negotiations for Korean association to HEU (Pillar II): how MSCA can prepare the ground for a successful association? (→ promotion of Staff Exchange actions and of Doctoral Networks);
- Dedicated promotion activities in Korea in cooperation with MSCA-Net, EURAXESS WW and EU Delegation targeting specific universities e.g. Korea University, KAIST, KIST and IBS (→ the ones 'missed' so far);
- **As well as**: Preparing MSCA **promotion material in English and Korean** in cooperation with MSCA-Net, EURAXESS WW and NCPs; **bi-lingula online promotion of MSCA related events**; **identification of Korean best practice examples** in MSCA to disseminate them to broader audiences; etc.
