

Al Act – For Trustworthy Al in Europe

Risk-based rules for AI systems:

Al with unacceptable risk is prohibited e.g. social scoring, biometrics

Requirements for high-risk AI e.g. AI in employment, medical devices

Disclosure for AI with transparency risks e.g. chatbots who impersonate humans


No rules for AI with minimal risk e.g. AI enabled videogames, spam filters







Al Act – For Trustworthy Al in Europe



General-purpose AI models

= highly capable AI models used at the basis of AI systems such as ChatGPT

Transparency for all general-purpose AI models



Risk management for those with systemic risk



Code of practice developed together with ca. 1000 stakeholders with concrete measures and commitments on how to comply with these rules.



Actively participating in the International Network of AI Safety Institutes along with the Republic of Korea, Australia, Canada, France, Japan, Kenya, Singapore, the United Kingdom and the United States.
