Represents 29 percent of all doctoral education in Sweden, with approximately 5 000 active doctoral students. (Karolinska Institutet: 2 173, KTH: 1 532, Stockholm University: 1 282)

Educates 15 percent of Sweden's students, with approximately 50,000 full-time equivalent students. (Karolinska Institutet: 6 517, KTH: 13 995, Stockholm University: 29 400)

One of the Stockholm region's largest workplace, with approximately 16,000 employees (Karolinska Institutet: 5 553, KTH: 5 286, Stockholm University: 5 459).

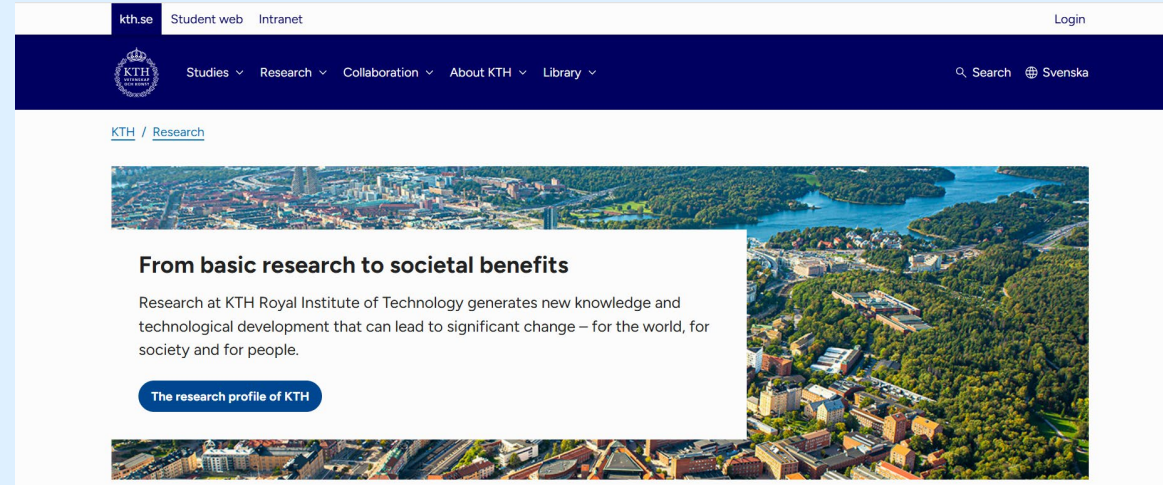
